How many other creatures can you find in your garden or local park?

For younger children you can imitate the movements to the creatures in the song.

For older children you can try and create your own lyrics to the song and make up your own verses.

The Chord progression for the 16 bar blues is like this. There is a 4 bar Chord introduction which is looped at the beginning of each verse.

You can create your own band depending on your musical knowledge and ability.

On Piano play these 3 note chords with your right hand play the Base note in your left.

On Guitar or Ukulele strum these chords as you sing.

With Chime bars play the notes C F and G.

You can simply sing it with un -tuned percussion instruments such as maracas tambourines or tapping sticks. Each creature can have a different sound.

Have fun jamming to this lovely blues song while learning about nature.
